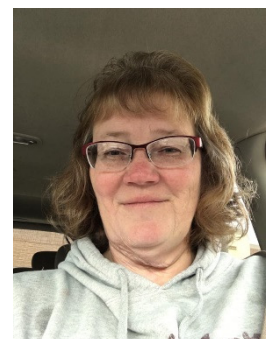
GOVERNORS NIGHT AND CHRISTMAS PARTY
